Graduate Mobility Award 2016-17

- Call for applications
- Mobility opportunity for graduate students participating in an international research collaboration
- Applications accepted on a rolling basis

Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) is launching the Graduate Mobility Award to encourage graduate students to study and conduct research abroad as part of their McGill degree program. Students will be awarded the Graduate Mobility Award based on academic unit and faculty **nomination**.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Graduate Mobility Award, the student must meet the following requirements:

- Enrolled in a graduate degree program at McGill
- Registered as a full-time thesis student at the time of travel
- Completed one full-time term at the time of application
- Nominated by his/her academic unit and faculty to take part in a mobility opportunity
- Be in good academic standing (students must have held an advisory/supervisory committee meeting within 10 months of the departure date)
- Travel must take place between October 1, 2016 and August 31, 2017
- Be participating in one or more of the following mobility activities:
 - Research stay at a lab abroad
 - Field work abroad
 - Participation in a formal bilateral exchange/research partnership abroad
 - *Travel must not be for conferences*
- Upon confirmation of award from Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS), academic units must <u>create a Travel Registry Form</u>. Students **must** complete their <u>form</u> before scheduled travel to receive funding.

Value of Award

Award values depend on where the mobility activity takes place, its duration and the availability of funding at the time of application.

How to Apply

- 1. Be nominated for the Graduate Mobility Award by his/her unit and faculty
- Complete <u>Graduate Mobility Award Application Form</u> (including Statement of Purpose & Required Signatures)
- 3. Submit a completed online Application Form
- 4. Submit supporting documents, including:
 - One letter of support from the McGill supervisor
 - One letter of support from a supervisor at the host institution
 - CV of the applicant
