This is a reminder that Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies (GPS) is now accepting applications for the 2017-18 Graduate Mobility Award. This award encourages graduate students to study and conduct research abroad as part of their McGill degree program. The award is available to full-time thesis students registered in a graduate program at McGill based on academic unit and Faculty approval.

Amendments to funding and reporting process

Please note the following amendments to the Graduate Mobility funding process **as of December 1, 2017**:

- Students travelling after December 1, 2017* will be required to complete a [short survey and provide proof of travel](#) (i.e. boarding pass) within one month of return. Students who fail to complete this step will see their award withdrawn.
- Students who cancel their travel may receive up to \$500 to cover the cost of cancellation fees, upon proof of costs incurred. Justification of cancellation is required.

*Please note that GPS will notify previously approved students whose travel is scheduled to take place after December 1, 2017 about the new reporting requirements.

Kindly be reminded that each student may only receive one award per academic year.
