The partnership allows Master's and PhD students and postdoctoral researchers registered full-time at McGill to benefit from various Mitacs fellowship and internship programs, by tapping into HBHL's growing network of industrial and academic partners.

Specifically offered are:

- 4-month to 3-year fellowships and internships at local and international companies
- 2-year fellowships for Postdoctoral researchers coupled with management training and an internship with an industrial partner
- Travel awards to work with selected university partners abroad for 4 months
