Tomlinson Doctoral Fellowships 2018-19

- Deadline for Unit to submit to GPS: **May 17, 2018**

Graduate and Postdoctoral Studies administers an annual Tomlinson Doctoral Fellowships competition. The deadline for receipt of nominated applications to GPS for the 2018-19 competition is **Thursday, May 17th, 2018**. Individual units may require an earlier internal review deadline to pre-screen and select their nominations. GPS will accept a maximum of 1 nomination per unit*.

Late, incomplete or handwritten applications will not be considered.

Eligibility

- The Tomlinson Doctoral Fellowships are for incoming students accepted into a doctoral degree at McGill University with a start date of Fall 2018. Students currently enrolled at McGill, or whose latest degree was completed or in progress at McGill, are ineligible.
- Only applicants with a 1st class academic record are eligible. McGill considers a first-class GPA to be 3.7 (or 3.5 in Law) in each of the last two (2) years of full-time study at the undergraduate and post-graduate level.
