The Al Ghurair STEM Scholars Program aims to help Arab youth pursue studies at top-level universities through financial aid and a well-designed support system. Devoted to helping exceptional young Arabs with financial barriers, the Program supports these youth in obtaining their Master’s degree at McGill in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics.

Funding

Entering studies at McGill beginning in Fall 2018, students will receive funding to cover the following:

- McGill tuition
- Program/ancillary fees
- Health and dental insurance
- Student housing
- Monthly food allowance
- Winter clothing allowance
- Book allowance
- Monthly Stipend

Funding is provided for completing all credits required by the degree program during the typical duration of the Master’s degree based on a full time study.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the Al Ghurair STEM Scholars Program, candidates must:

- (a) be admitted to McGill in one of the [approved STEM-related Master's degree programs](#); and
- (b) meet the [Al Ghurair Foundation for Education](#) eligibility criteria.
