2020-21 McGill-Glasgow Collaboration Award

- Deadline to Apply: **January 15th, 2021**

The 2020-21 McGill-Glasgow Collaboration Award (usually the McGill-Glasgow Travel Award) competition is now open in an effort to increase opportunities for research collaboration under the current circumstances. The award supports PhD students and postdocs in any discipline seeking to strengthen research ties with the University of Glasgow. This year's competition is open for virtual collaboration projects only as University-related travel is currently heavily restricted.

Eligibility

All registered PhD students and postdocs in any discipline at McGill are eligible to apply for the award.

Value

- Up to \$2,000 depending on the scope of the proposal

How to Apply

Please submit the following documents to fundingapplications.gps@mcgill.ca:

1. A one-page statement of purpose
2. CV of the applicant
3. One letter of support from a McGill supervisor
4. One letter of support from a University of Glasgow supervisor
5. A budget for the activity
