External DFW for Chinese students

- Funding Opportunity for Chinese Master's and PhD students
- **Deadline: January 15th, 2021**

We would like to remind you about the Quebec-China international differential fee exemptions ([External DFWs](#)) available to Masters and PhD students from China to pursue their studies and research at McGill. Recipients are awarded a country exemption from the Quebec government, which reduces their tuition fees to the Quebec rate.

- New and current Chinese students are eligible as long as they have [residency terms](#) to complete. Students in Additional Session should not apply.
- **China Scholarship Council (CSC) recipients are no longer required to apply for External DFWs.** They will still receive the funding that was offered to them when they applied for CSC. However, they are strongly encouraged to apply for FRQ funding after their first year of studies at McGill. Students who have applied for the Fall 2021 CSC scholarship should wait for CSC results before applying.
- Application deadline: **January 15th, 2021**
- Students must apply through the [China Scholarship Council \(CSC\)](#). Results will be available directly from the agency.
- Recipients will be awarded a Quebec country exemption and pay Quebec tuition fees.
