Nominees must have received the master's degree within three years preceding the year of competition. Therefore, people who completed all requirements for the degree after January 1, 2018 are eligible.

All required documentation should be submitted by the student to the Department (ross.mackay@mcgill.ca) by the deadline of **December 2, 2020**, and which include:

- the thesis manuscript
- 300 word abstract in lay language
- three letters of evaluation
